**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Amendment Act 2007*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

**3 Legislation amended**

This Act amends the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999*.

*Note* This Act also amends the *Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005* (see s 5).

**4 Driver or rider to stop and give assistance  
Section 16, penalty**

*substitute*

Maximum penalty: 200 penalty units, imprisonment for 2 years or both.
