An Act to amend the Legal Profession Act 2006

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Legal Profession Amendment Act 2009.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the Legal Profession Act 2006.

Appointment of investigators New section 234 (3) and (4)

insert

- (3) An appointment may be made subject to conditions—
 - (a) stated in the instrument of appointment; or
 - (b) stated in a written notice given by the licensing body to the investigator during the term of appointment; or
 - (c) prescribed by regulation.
- (4) The licensing body may end the appointment of an investigator if the investigator breaches a condition of appointment.
 - *Note* A person's appointment also ends if the person resigns (see Legislation Act, s 210).

Appointment of investigator for complaint New section 407 (2) and (3)

Note The licensing body may give an investigator a written notice stating conditions of appointment during the term of the investigator's appointment (see s 234 (3) (b)).

9 Compensation for exercise of enforcement powers Section 549 (1)

- (1) A person may claim compensation from the relevant council if the person suffers loss or damage because of conduct of an investigator—
 - (a) in the exercise or purported exercise of a function under this part; and
 - (b) that is unlawful or unreasonable.

conduct means an act or omission to do an act.
