An Act to amend the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012* commences.

Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).

3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012*.

**Part 9.3 Transitional—Road Transport
(Third-Party Insurance)
Amendment Act 2012**

291 Personal injury

- (1) This section applies to a claim for personal injury that arises out of a motor accident that happened before the commencement of the [Road Transport \(Third-Party Insurance\) Amendment Act 2012](#).
- (2) The claim for the personal injury must be dealt with as if that Act had not been enacted.

292 Expiry—pt 9.3

This part expires 1 year after the day it commences.

Note Transitional provisions are kept in the Act for a limited time. A transitional provision is repealed on its expiry but continues to have effect after its repeal (see [Legislation Act](#), s 88).
