

# **Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Amendment Act 2016**

An Act to amend the Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Act 2006

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

## 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Amendment Act 2016.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

*Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

## 3 Legislation amended

This Act amends the *Terrorism (Extraordinary Temporary Powers) Act* 2006.

## 100 Review of Act after 13 years of operation

The Minister must—

- (a) review the operation and effectiveness of this Act after it has been in operation for 13 years; and
- (b) present a report of the review to the Legislative Assembly before the end of the Act's 14th year of operation (19 November 2020).
