An Ordinance to amend the *Family Provision Ordinance 1969*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Family Provision (Amendment) Ordinance 1989*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance commences on such date as is fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, “Principal Ordinance” means the *Family Provision Ordinance 1969*.²

Persons entitled to apply

4. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting subsections (5) and (6).

Saving

5. Notwithstanding the amendment effected by section 4, the Principal Ordinance as in force immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance applies in relation to applications under subsection 7 (1) of the Principal Ordinance in respect of the estates of people who died before that commencement.
