If any question arises as to the adequacy of the amount paid into Court, such question, and all questions as to who are dependants, and the amount payable to such dependants, must be settled by arbitration in accordance with the *Workers Compensation Act 1951* and the *Workers Compensation Rules 1938*.

If no question arises as to the adequacy of the amount paid into Court, any persons interested in the said sum may apply to the Court for an order for the investment and application of the said sum for the benefit of the persons entitled to it in accordance with the *Workers' Compensation Act 1951*, schedule 1, clause 6, and the *Workers Compensation Rules 1938*.
