### Nature of notice

- the respondent claims to be entitled to contribution from you in relation to compensation claimed by the applicant from the respondent in respect of a disease (Act, s 27 (Compensation for death or incapacity through disease)) on the ground that you employed the worker in employment that caused or contributed to the disease prior to the liability of the respondent arising
