- Fireworks must not be used during a total fire ban. It is the consumer's responsibility to check that a total fire ban is not in place at the time of using fireworks.
- All Consumer Fireworks must be transported, stored and used in a safe and secure manner in accordance with the instructions given by the supplier.

IT IS AN OFFENCE TO POSSESS OR USE CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES (INCLUDING CONSUMER FIREWORKS) WITHOUT AN AUTHORITY. MAXIMUM PENALTY \$75,000 AND/OR THREE YEARS IMPRISONMENT.
