Nature of notice

- the respondent claims to be entitled to be indemnified by you against liability to pay compensation to the applicant (Workers Compensation Act, s 13 (Subcontracting)) on the ground that at the time of the injury for which compensation is claimed the applicant was immediately employed by you in the execution of work undertaken by the respondent in relation to which the respondent had contracted with you for execution of the work by or under you

Filed for the respondent by:

(the respondent's address for service and telephone number (if any) or, if the respondent is represented by a solicitor and the solicitor is the agent of another solicitor, the name and place of business of the other solicitor)

- the respondent claims to be entitled to contribution from you in relation to compensation claimed by the applicant from the respondent in respect of a disease (Workers Compensation Act, s 27 (Compensation for death or incapacity through disease)) on the ground that you employed the worker in employment that caused or contributed to the disease before the liability of the respondent arose

Notice to third-party respondent

You must give a copy of this third-party notice to your insurer not later than 7 days after the day you are served with the notice.

You may file an answer to this third-party notice in the Court not later than 28 days after the day the notice is served on you (see r 3913 (Application for arbitration—answer by respondent or third-party respondent)).

If you do not file an answer within this time, you are liable to have an order made against you.
