- (iii) for any "complying community legal centre" as defined in s n.

It is a condition of this practising certificate under s n that I practise only in the capacities stated at (i) to (iii).

OTHER NOTIFIABLE INFORMATION

9. I have read the definition in the Dictionary to the Act of "**serious offence**". I understand that I must notify the Law Society in writing within 7 days if I am charged with a "**serious offence**" or if I am convicted of any offence that would require disclosure under the admission rules in relation to an application for admission to the legal profession under the Act. I understand that I must **attach** to this application a written statement about any "**show-cause events**" that have occurred in relation to me since my admission to the legal profession and that have not been previously notified to the Law Society.
