IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1997

Civil Partnership Act 2008

This form is to be used in accordance with section 10 of the *Civil Partnerships Act 2008* (the Act), to give notice to the Registrar-General of the intention to withdraw a notice to terminate a civil partnership. Applicants should be aware of their responsibilities under the *Civil Partnerships Act 2008*. You can view or download the Act from <u>www.legislation.act.gov.au</u>.

GENERAL INFORMATION

A notice to terminate a civil partnership may only be withdrawn by the party, or parties, who gave the termination notice, before the end of 12 months after the day the termination notice was given to the Registrar-General.

If the notice is given to the Registrar-General by only 1 party, it is effective only if:

- a copy of the notice has been served personally on the other party; and,
- the attached statutory declaration is completed by the person who served the withdrawal of termination notice, including the date on which it was served.

To serve this notice personally on a party, the person serving the notice must:

- give the party a copy of the notice;
- if the party does not accept the notice, put the copy down in the party's presence and tell the party in general terms what it is; or,
- if the person serving the notice is prevented from approaching the party by violence or threat of violence, or by a court order, put the copy down as near as practicable to, but in sight of the party.

A civil partnership is terminated upon the death or marriage of either party.

Please note 3 forms of current identification must be provided upon lodgement of this form. If lodged by both parties, each person must provide 3 forms of identification.

PRIVACY INFORMATION

The *Births, Deaths and Marriages registration Act 1997* authorises the Registrar-General to collect the information required by this form. The Registrar-General prevents any unreasonable intrusion into a person's privacy in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* (C'wlth). The Registrar-General may provide identifiable information to law enforcement organisations and authorised organisations that have legal authority to request information under prescribed circumstances. Documents provided as proof of identity may have their authenticity verified through Certificate Validation Service (CVS) and the National Document Verification System (DVS). Documents issued by this office may also be verified by external agencies using CVS and/or DVS.
