This Application form should be used for applications to the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal (the ACAT) for trespass actions.

A 'trespass' is an unauthorised, uninvited entry onto your land. If a person remains on your land after being told to leave the person is trespassing.

You can apply for particular orders to deal with a trespass. An example is an application for an order requiring a squatter to leave your land. You can also recover monetary damages.
