Should a "**show-cause event**" occur while I am holding this practising certificate, I must give the ACT Law Society written notice within 7 days of the event and further information within 28 days (<u>s 61</u>).

- 11. I understand that the ACT Law Society cannot grant me a practising certificate unless satisfied that I am a 'fit and proper person' to hold the certificate (<u>ss 44(3) and (4)</u>). <u>Sections 11 and 36</u> contain criteria that are relevant to whether a person is a 'fit and proper person'.
