

Form 5 Arrest and removal order

Crimes (Forensic Procedures) Act 2000

(see s 40A (Magistrate may order arrest etc of suspect not in custody for carrying out forensic procedure))

In the *[Magistrates/Childrens] Court of the Australian Capital Territory

Criminal jurisdiction
