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ACT HERITAGE REGISTER— REGISTER AMENDMENT APPLICATION Heritage Act 2004, s24

The ACT Heritage Register contains details of places and objects of significance to the ACT.

This register amendment application form is used to amend the registration details of a place or object entered in the ACT Heritage Register.

Any person can make an application to amend the registration details for a place or object. The registration details for which this form may be used to request amendment are the name, description (including boundary), and/or the statement of heritage significance including assessment against the heritage significance criteria for a registered place or object.

In making this application, you are asked to identify the requested amendments and provide supporting evidence. The fields in the application form will guide you with this.

Any mistakes or omissions in a heritage register entry do not require the use of this form and can be reported directly to ACT Heritage on 13 22 81 or by email to heritage@act.gov.au

The ACT Heritage Council will notify you as soon as possible about its acceptance or dismissal of this application, and progress of associated processes and decisions. The Council may dismiss the application if the Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the application is frivolous, vexatious, misconceived, lacking in substance or not made honestly; or the Council has previously decided not to correct or change the register in the way proposed, and is satisfied that the application shows no substantial new reasons for correction or change.

No fee is payable for making an application for a register amendment.
