An Act to amend legislation because of the enactment of the *Annual Reports (Government Agencies) Act 2004*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Annual Reports Legislation Amendment Act 2004*.

3 **2 Commencement**

4 This Act commences on the commencement of the *Annual Reports*
5 (*Government Agencies*) Act 2004, section 3.

6 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
7 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

8 **3 Legislation amended—sch 1**

9 This Act amends the legislation mentioned in schedule 1.
