1 Name of Act

This Act is the Insurance Levy Legislation Repeal Act 2001.

2 Commencement

- 5 (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day this Act is notified in the Gazette.
 - (2) Sections 4 and 5 commence on 1 July 2002.
 - (3) An amendment in schedule 1 commences on the date mentioned (after 'commencement:') at the end of the amendment.

10 Example

An amendment in the schedule followed by '(commencement: 1 July 2001)' indicates that the amendment commences on 1 July 2001.

15 4 Repeal of Insurance Levy Act 1998

5 Repeal of Insurance Levy Regulations
