An Act to amend the Psychologists Act 1994

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1 Name of Act
 - This Act is the Psychologists Amendment Act 2000.
- 5 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.

3 Act amended

This Act amends the Psychologists Act 1994.

4 Interpretation

Section 3 is amended—

- (a) by omitting the heading and substituting the following heading:
 - "3 Definitions"; and
- (b) by omitting "(1) In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—" and substituting "In this Act:"; and
- (c) by omitting subsection (2).

5 Insertion

After section 3 the following section is inserted:

10 "3A When does a person practise psychology

For this Act, a person is taken to practise psychology if—

- (a) the person practises psychology on his or her own account; or
- (b) the person practises psychology as an officer or employee of someone else.".
