An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1900

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1 Name of Act
 - This Act is the Crimes Amendment Act (No 2) 1999.
- 5 2 Commencement
 - This Act commences on the day it is notified in the Gazette.
 - 3 Act amended
 - This Act amends the Crimes Act 1900.
 - 4 Insertion
- After section 406 the following section is inserted:

Crimes Amendment (No 2) No , 1999

"407 Abolition of presumption of marital coercion

Any presumption of law that an offence committed by a wife in the presence of her husband is committed under the coercion of the husband is abolished.".
