**Air Pollution (Amendment) Bill (No. 2)**

**A BILL**  
**FOR**

**An Act to amend the *Air Pollution Act 1984***

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**Short title**

- 5       1. This Act may be cited as the *Air Pollution (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1996*.

**Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

**Principal Act**

- 10       3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Air Pollution Act 1984*.<sup>1</sup>

**Permits for burning plant matter**

4. Section 27A of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting subparagraphs (2) (a) (i) and (ii) and substituting the following subparagraphs:

- 5           “(i) to reduce a fire hazard;  
             (ii) to clear the land; or  
             (iii) to conserve biological diversity or ecological integrity;  
             and”; and

(b) by omitting subsection (3).
