Animal Diseases (Amendment) Bill 1996

**An Act to amend the *Animal Diseases Act 1993* and
for a related purpose**

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Animal Diseases (Amendment) Act 1996*.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

Principal Act

- 10 3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Animal Diseases Act 1993*.¹

Interpretation

4. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “animal” and substituting the following definition:

“ ‘animal’ includes—

- 5
- (a) a vertebrate and an invertebrate;
 - (b) a carcass of an animal; and
 - (c) an egg, embryo, ovum or sperm, or other product, of an animal from which another animal could be produced;

but does not include a human being;”.

10 **Repeal of *Apiaries Act 1928***

5. The *Apiaries Act 1928* is repealed.
