**Discrimination (Amendment) Bill 1995**

**A BILL  
FOR**

**An Act to amend the *Discrimination Act 1991***

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**Short title**

- 5       1. This Act may be cited as the *Discrimination (Amendment) Act 1995*.

**Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the *Gazette*.

**Principal Act**

- 10       3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Discrimination Act 1991*.<sup>1</sup>

**Insertion**

4. After section 5 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Part I:

**MLAs as employers**

- 5 “6. For the purposes of this Act, a member of the Legislative Assembly shall be taken to be an employer in relation to a person who is, or who is seeking to be, employed, under section 5 or 10 of the *Legislative Assembly (Members’ Staff) Act 1989*, as a member of the staff of the member.”.
