Discrimination (Amendment) Bill 1995

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the Discrimination Act 1991

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Discrimination (Amendment) Act 5 1995.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

Principal Act

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3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Discrimination Act 1991.¹

Insertion

4. After section 5 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Part I:

Job No.: 1995/43

MLAs as employers

"6. For the purposes of this Act, a member of the Legislative Assembly shall be taken to be an employer in relation to a person who is, or who is seeking to be, employed, under section 5 or 10 of the Legislative Assembly
[Members' Staff] Act 1989, as a member of the staff of the member.".
