An Act to amend the Motor Traffic Act 1936

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act 1995.

5 Commencement

- 2. (1) Sections 1, 2 and 3 commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.
- (2) Section 4 commences on a day fixed by the Minister by notice in the Gazette.
- 10 (3) If section 4 has not commenced before the end of the period of 6 months commencing on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*, that provision, by force of this subsection, commences on the first day after the end of that period.

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Motor Traffic Act 1936.

Substitution

4. Section 112C of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted:

Signs permitting left turns

"112C. Notwithstanding section 112B, where traffic lights are erected at an intersection or junction of 1 public street with another public street, the driver of a motor vehicle approaching the intersection or junction may, subject to section 112D, turn the motor vehicle to his or her left into another public street at that intersection or junction.".
