FOR

An Act to amend the Drugs of Dependence Act 1989

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Drugs of Dependence (Amendment)
5. Act 1994.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazene.

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Drugs of Dependence Act 1989.

Offence notices

- 4. Section 171A of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting subsection (6) and substituting the following subsection:
- 5 "(6) Proceedings do not lie against a person in respect of the alleged commission of a simple cannabis offence unless—
 - (a) an offence notice has been served on the person; and
 - (b) at the expiration of 60 days after the date of service of the notice the prescribed penalty has not been paid.";
- 10 (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of "simple cannabis offence" in subsection (7) "or" (last occurring);
 - (c) by adding at the end of paragraph (b) of the definition of "simple cannabis offence" in subsection (7) "or";
 - (d) by adding at the end of the definition of "simple cannabis offence" in subsection (7) the following paragraph:
 - "(c) an offence under subsection 171 (2) of administering, or causing or permitting to be administered, to oneself cannabis."; and
 - (e) by omitting from subsection (8) "\$100" and substituting "\$40".
