# Noise Control (Amendment) Bill 1993

#### A BILL

## FOR

# An Act to amend the Noise Control Act 1988

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

# Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Noise Control (Amendment) Act 1993.

### 5 Commencement

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the Gazette.

#### Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Noise Control Act 1988.1

#### 10 Noise direction notice

4. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (3) and substituting the following subsection:

"(3) Where—

#### Noise Control (Amendment) , 1993 No.

- (a) an exemption under section 16 is in force in respect of premises; and
- (b) there has been no breach of any condition to which that exemption is subject;
- a noise direction notice in respect of noise of the kind to which the 5 exemption relates is invalid.".

#### Exemption

#### 5. Section 16 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) "writing" and substituting "writing and subject to any reasonable condition";
- (b) by adding at the end of subsection (3) "or vary any condition to which the exemption is subject";
- (c) by adding at the end of subsection (4) "or vary any condition to which the exemption is subject"; and
- (d) by inserting in subsection (5) "or to make an exemption subject to any condition or to vary a condition," after "exemption,".

#### **Disallowable instrument**

6. Section 20 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "is a disallowable instrument" and substituting ", and any amendment to the 20 Manual, are disallowable instruments".

#### **Review of decisions**

Section 44 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting 7. paragraph (2) (b) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- "(b) granting, granting subject to a condition, revoking or refusing to revoke an exemption under section 16;
- (ba) varying or refusing to vary any condition to which an exemption under section 16 is subject;".
