Administration (Amendment) Bill 1989

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Administration Act 1989*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Administration (Amendment) Act 1989*.

5 **Delegations**

2. Section 5 of the *Administration Act 1989*¹ is amended—

- 10 (a) by omitting from subsection (2) “this section” and substituting “that subsection”;
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) “This section has” and substituting “Subsections (1) and (2) have”; and
- 15 (c) by adding at the end the following subsections:
- “(4) An administrative head may, by instrument, delegate to any person all or any of his or her powers under—
- (a) a Commonwealth Act;
- (b) an instrument of a legislative nature (including a regulation, rule or by-law) made under a Commonwealth Act; or

(c) an instrument of delegation made under a Commonwealth Act.

"(5) Subsection (4) extends to the sub-delegation by an Associate Head of Administration of a power delegated to him or her by the Head of Administration under that subsection."
