**A BILL**

FOR

**An Act to amend the *Motor Traffic Act 1936***

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

**Short title**

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No. 2) 1990*.

**Principal Act**

2. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*.<sup>1</sup>

**Learner drivers**

- 10 3. Section 9 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (1A) (c) and substituting the following paragraphs:

"(c) in the case of a permit licence to ride a motor cycle—

- 15 (i) is at least 16 years and 9 months of age; and  
(ii) has, within 3 months prior to applying for the permit licence, successfully completed a motor cycle rider training course approved by the Registrar by notice in the *Gazette*;  
or

(d) in any other case—is at least 16 years and 9 months of age."
