**Motor Traffic (Amendment) Bill (No. 5)
1990**

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Motor Traffic (Amendment) Act (No. 5) 1990*.

Commencement

2. (1) Section 1 and this section commence on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*.

10 (2) Section 3 commences on a day fixed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

(3) If section 3 has not commenced before the end of the period of 6 months commencing on the day on which this Act is notified in the *Gazette*, that section, by force of this subsection, commences on the first day after the end of that period.

15 **Substitution**

3. Section 36 of the *Motor Traffic Act 1936*¹ is repealed and the following section substituted:

Taxi fares

“36. (1) The Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, determine the maximum fares chargeable for the hiring of a taxi.

“(2) A notice under subsection (1) is a disallowable instrument for the purposes of section 10 of the *Subordinate Laws Act 1989*.”.
