Lakes (Amendment) Bill 1990

A BILL

FOR

An Act to amend the *Lakes Act 1976*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts
as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Lakes (Amendment) Act 1990*.

5 **Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the day on which it is notified in the
Gazette.

Principal Act

3. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Lakes Act 1976*.¹

Lights to be Carried on Large Power Boats

4. Section 38 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting “sub-sections (2) and (3)” from sub-section (6) and substituting “sub-sections (3) and (4)”; and
- (b) by omitting “sub-section (1)” from subsection (6) and substituting “sub-section (2)”. 5

Lights to be Carried by Other Boats

5. Section 39 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following sections substituted:

“39. A power boat, other than a boat to which section 38 applies, shall carry a white light visible at a distance of not less than 1.5 kilometres, from all compass points.” 10

“39A. A sailing vessel underway shall show sidelights, as described in sub-sections 38 (3) and 38 (4) and a sternlight as described in sub-section 38 (5).” 15
