**Electricity and Water (Amendment) Bill
1991**

**A BILL
FOR**

An Act to amend the *Electricity and Water Act 1988*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

Short title

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Electricity and Water (Amendment) Act 1991*.

Principal Act

2. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the *Electricity and Water Act 1988*.¹

Interpretation

- 10 3. Section 74A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of "elector of the Territory".

Repeal

4. Section 74D of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section substituted:

Exempt treatments

5 "74D. Section 74B does not apply in relation to the addition by the Authority to the water supply system of the Territory of—

- (a) a chemical for the purpose of clarifying or purifying the water in that system at a concentration that would not be injurious to public health; or
- 10 (b) fluoride at a concentration not exceeding 1 milligram per litre."

Repeal

5. Sections 74E and 74F of the Principal Act are repealed.
