Administration (Interstate Agreements) Repeal Bill 2005

A Bill for

An Act to amend and repeal the *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Repeal*
3 *Act 2005*.

4 **2 Commencement**

5 This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

6 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
7 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

8 **3 Legislation repealed**

9 The *Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997* A1997-115 is
10 repealed.

11 **4 Administration (Interstate Agreements) Act 1997,**
12 **new section 5A**

13 *in part 1, insert*

14 **5A Ending of application of Act**

15 (1) This Act ceases to apply in relation to interstate agreements and any
16 negotiations for them.

17 (2) Subsection (1) has effect despite the Legislation Act, section 84
18 (Saving of operation of repealed and amended laws).

19 (3) This section is declared to be a law to which the Legislation Act,
20 section 88 (Repeal does not end effect of transitional laws etc)
21 applies.
