2			This Act is the Financial Management Amendment Act 2007.

4			This Act commences on the day after its notification day.

12		(1)	This section applies if—		
13 14			(a) an employee entitlement exists in relation to an entity in a financial year; and		
15 16			(b) the entity has paid, or is required to pay, the entitlement in the financial year; and		
17 18 19			(c) the amount of the entitlement exceeds the amount appropriated for the entity in relation to employee entitlements for the financial year.		
20 21		(2)	The Treasurer may, in writing, authorise an appropriation for the entity in relation to the amount.		
22 23 24 25		(3)	If the Treasurer authorises an appropriation under this section, the Treasurer must present a copy of the authorisation to the Legislative Assembly within 3 sitting days after the day the appropriation is authorised.

2 3		<i>entity</i> means a department, territory authority or territory-owned corporation.
4	16B	Rollover of undispersed appropriation
5 6 7	(1)	This section applies to an amount of appropriation if, at the end of the financial year in which the appropriation is made, the amount is not dispersed to the entity to which it is appropriated.
8 9	(2)	The Treasurer may, in writing, authorise the amount to be dispersed to the entity in the following financial year.
10 11	(3)	The Treasurer may give the authorisation in the financial year in which the appropriation is made, or in the following financial year.
12	(4)	The authorisation must identify—
13		(a) the entity to which the amount is to be dispersed; and
14		(b) the appropriation type; and
15		(c) the amount authorised to be dispersed; and
16		(d) the purpose for which the amount may be dispersed.
17 18	(5)	If the Treasurer authorises an amount to be dispersed under this section—
19 20 21		(a) the amount is taken to be an amount of appropriation for the financial year in which the amount is authorised to be dispersed; and
22 23		(b) the amount is in addition to the appropriation to the entity for that financial year.
24 25 26 27	(6)	If the Treasurer authorises an amount to be dispersed under this section, the Treasurer must present a copy of the authorisation to the Legislative Assembly within 3 sitting days after the day the appropriation is authorised.
