An Act to amend the *Holidays Act 1958*, and for other purposes

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

		This Act is the Holidays (Canberra Day) Amendment Act 2007.		
2		Commencement		
		This Act commences on the day after its notification day.		
		<i>Note</i> The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence or the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

		This Act amends the Holidays Act 1958.		
		Note This Act also amends the Road Transport (Offences) Regulation 2005 (see s 6).

		(iii) the 2nd Monday in March (Canberra Day);		
		Note For 2007, the Canberra Day public holiday is 19 March 2007 (ie the 3rd Monday in March (see s 6)).
