2			This Act is the Water Resources (Validation of Fees) Act 2008.		
3	2		Commencement		
4			This Act commences on the day after its notification day.		
5 6			<i>Note</i> The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

8			A note included in this Act is explanatory and is not part of this Act.

11	4		Water Resources (Fees) Determination—effect		
12 13 14 15		(1)	Despite the repeal of the <i>Water Resources (Fees) Determination</i> 2006 (No 1) (DI2006-138), the determination has effect, and is taken always to have had effect, for all purposes as if it had continued in force until the end of 31 July 2007.		
16 17		(2)	This section is a law to which the Legislation Act, section 88 (Repeal does not end effect of transitional laws etc) applies.		
18 19 20			<i>Note</i> If a law validates something that is or may otherwise be invalid, the validating effect of the law does not end merely because of the repeal of the law (see Legislation Act, s 88 (1)).		
21	5		Expiry of Act		
22			This Act expires on the day after its notification day.
