An Act to amend the *Electricity Feed-in (Renewable Energy Premium)* Act 2008

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

2 3			This Act is the <i>Electricity Feed-in (Renewable Energy Premium)</i> Amendment Act 2010.

5 6			This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.
7 8			<i>Note 1</i> The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

23 24 25			<i>renewable energy generator</i> means an energy generator that generates electricity from a renewable energy source, and includes—
26			(a) a micro renewable energy generator; and

2			renewable energy source means any of the following:

5			(c) any other source determined by the Minister.

9	5C		Meaning of <i>capacity</i>
10		(1)	In this Act:
11			<i>capacity</i> , of a renewable energy generator, means—
12 13			(a) if the generator is a solar photovoltaic generator—the rated power output of the panels of the generator; or
14 15 16			(b) if the Minister determines a method for measuring the capacity of a generator under subsection (2)—the capacity measured by the determined method.
17 18		(2)	The Minister may determine the method for measuring the capacity of renewable energy generators.
19 20 21			<i>Note</i> Power to make a statutory instrument (including a regulation) includes power to make different provision for different categories (see Legislation Act, s 48).
22		(3)	A determination is a disallowable instrument.

4 5 6			<i>medium renewable energy generator</i> means a renewable energy generator that has a total capacity more than 30kW but not more than 200kW.
7 8			<i>micro renewable energy generator</i> means a renewable energy generator that has a total capacity not more than 30kW.
9	5E		Meaning of <i>compliant</i>
10		(1)	For this Act, a renewable energy generator is <i>compliant</i> if—
11			(a) the generator is installed on premises in the ACT; and
12 13			(b) when connected to the electricity distributor's network, it complies with the service and installation rules; and
14 15 16			(c) the total capacity of the generator, or the total capacity of all renewable energy generators installed on the premises, is not more than—
17			(i) 200kW; or
18 19			(ii) if the Minister determines another capacity under subsection (2)—the applicable determined capacity; and
20 21 22 23			 (d) if the generator is a micro renewable generator—the generator is connected to the electricity distributor's network before the total capacity of all micro renewable energy generators connected to the network reaches—
