## **Justice and Community Safety Legislation Amendment Bill 2011 (No 2)**

---

### **A Bill for**

An Act to amend legislation about justice and community safety

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Justice and Community Safety Legislation*  
3 *Amendment Act 2011 (No 2)*.

4 **2 Commencement**

5 (1) This Act (other than schedule 1, part 1.8) commences on the  
6 14th day after its notification day.

7 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on  
8 the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

9 (2) Schedule 1, part 1.8 is taken to have commenced on 29 July 2008.

11 This Act amends the legislation mentioned in schedule 1.

10 (i) the size of a page;

11 (ii) margin standards;

13 (iv) the number of copies required;

14 (v) the page numbering standards; and

15 (b) the following matters in relation to an electronic image:

16 (i) the size of the image;

17 (ii) electronic formatting standards;

18 (iii) alteration standards;

19 (iv) page numbering standards; and

20 (c) in relation to a data set—page numbering standards.

21 3 An approved format requirement is a notifiable instrument.

22 *Note* A notifiable instrument must be notified under the Legislation Act.
