An Act to amend the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

- 1 **1 Name of Act**
- 2 This Act is the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment*
3 *Act 2012 (No 2)*.
- 4 **2 Commencement**
- 5 This Act commences on the day the *Road Transport (Third-Party*
6 *Insurance) Amendment Act 2012* commences.
- 7 *Note* The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on
8 the notification day (see [Legislation Act](#), s 75 (1)).
- 9 **3 Legislation amended**
- 10 This Act amends the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance)*

1 **291 Personal injury**

2 (1) This section applies to a claim for personal injury that arises out of a
3 motor accident that happened before the commencement of the
4 *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Amendment Act 2012*.

5 (2) The claim for the personal injury must be dealt with as if that Act
6 had not been enacted.

7 **292 Expiry—pt 9.3**

8 This part expires 1 year after the day it commences.

9 *Note* Transitional provisions are kept in the Act for a limited time.
10 A transitional provision is repealed on its expiry but continues to have
11 effect after its repeal (see [Legislation Act](#), s 88).
