An Act to amend the *Public Sector Management Act 1994* and the *Workplace Privacy Amendment Act 2016*

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

3		This Act is the Workplace Legislation Amendment Act 2018.
4	2	Commencement
5		This Act commences on the day after its notification day.
6 7		Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).

6 7		(1)	A public servant must repay any amount paid by the Territory to the public servant to which the public servant is not legally entitled.
8 9		(2)	Subsection (1) applies regardless of when the overpayment was made.
10 11		(3)	The arrangements for repayment may be agreed between the head of service and the public servant.
2 3 4 5		(4)	If the head of service and the public servant cannot agree on an arrangement for repayment within, in the opinion of the head of service, a reasonable period, the head of service may determine reasonable arrangements for repayment having regard to—
16			(a) the period in which the overpayment occurred; and
17			(b) the circumstances of the overpayment; and
18			(c) the gross and net amount of the overpayment; and
19			(d) the public servant's financial circumstances; and
20 21			(e) any hardship the arrangement may cause to the public servant; and

25			(a) the deduction of amounts from the public servant's salary; and
