A Bill for

An Act to amend the Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1	1	Name of Act
2		This Act is the Canberra Institute of Technology Amendment Act 2018.
4	2	Commencement
5		This Act commences on a day fixed by the Minister by written notice.
6 7		Note 1 The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
8 9 10		Note 2 A single day or time may be fixed, or different days or times may be fixed, for the commencement of different provisions (see Legislation Act, s 77 (1)).
11 12 13		Note 3 If a provision has not commenced within 6 months beginning on the notification day, it automatically commences on the first day after that period (see Legislation Act, s 79).

14			(e) 1 student at the CIT (the <i>student member</i>);
15			(f) at least 2, but not more than 6, other members.
16 17			Note 1 The chair and deputy chair may be appointed by the Minister under the <i>Financial Management Act 1996</i> , s 79.
18 19			Note 2 The chief executive officer is appointed by the CIT board after consulting the Minister (see <i>Financial Management Act 1996</i> , s 80 (2)).
20 21			Note 3 Other members of the CIT board are appointed by the Minister under the <i>Financial Management Act 1996</i> , s 78.
