Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration (Tissue Donor Acknowledgment) Amendment Bill 2020

A Bill for

An Act to amend the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1997

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1	1		Name of Act
2			This Act is the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration (Tissue Donor Acknowledgment) Amendment Act 2020.
4	2		Commencement
5			This Act commences on the day after its notification day.
6 7			Note The naming and commencement provisions automatically commence on the notification day (see Legislation Act, s 75 (1)).
8	3		Legislation amended
9 10			This Act amends the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1997.

13	38A		Information about tissue donation
14 15		(1)	This section applies in relation to a deceased person who was a tissue donor and whose death is or is to be registered under this Act.
16 17 18		(2)	On request by a next of kin of the deceased person, the registrar-general must include in the register a statement that the person was a tissue donor.
19 20		(3)	The request must be in writing and include information verifying that the deceased person was a tissue donor.
21 22		(4)	Additionally, if the next of kin wishes to receive from the Chief Minister a written acknowledgment of the tissue donation—
23 24			(a) the next of kin may give the registrar-general a written request for the acknowledgment, including their name and address; and
25 26			(b) the registrar-general must ensure that the request is given to the Chief Minister.

4		tissue donor—a deceased person was a tissue donor if—		
5		(a) tissue was removed from the person's body while the person was		
6		living, under a consent given in accordance with the

8		by adults) or division 2.3 (Donations from children); or		
9		(b) tissue was removed from the person's body under a consent		
0		given in accordance with that Act, part 3 (Donations of tissue		
1		after death).
