An Act to appropriate additional money for the purposes of the Territory for the financial year that began on 1 July 2022

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

13			financial year means the year that began on 1 July 2022.

(2) The amount mentioned in schedule 1, part 1.20 (Treasurer's Advance), column 5 is appropriated to the Treasurer's Advance for the *Financial Management Act 1996*, section 18.
