## **Financial Management Amendment Bill 2001 (No 4)**

---

### **A Bill for**

An Act to amend the *Financial Management Act 1996*

---

The Legislative Assembly for the Australian Capital Territory enacts as follows:

1 **1 Name of Act**

2 This Act is the *Financial Management Amendment Act 2001 (No 4)*.

3 **2 Commencement**

4 This Act commences on its notification day.

5 **3 Act amended**

6 This Act amends the *Financial Management Act 1996*.

7 **4 Section 13**

8 *substitute*

9 **13 Supplementary budget papers**

10 (1) The Treasurer must, on the presentation of a Bill for an  
11 Appropriation Act other than the first Appropriation Act relating to  
12 a financial year, present to the Legislative Assembly supplementary  
13 budget papers.

14 (2) The supplementary budget papers must, for each department for  
15 which an appropriation is provided by the Bill (an *affected*  
16 *department*)—

17 (a) state, for each purpose mentioned in section 8—

18 (i) the amount of the appropriation provided in the first  
19 Appropriation Act; and

20 (ii) the variations (if any) previously made to the  
21 appropriation under this Act; and

22 (iii) the amount of the appropriation provided by the Bill; and

23 (iv) the total amount appropriated for the department for the  
24 financial year; and

25 (b) indicate the impact of the proposed variation.

- 1 (3) For subsection (2) (b), the supplementary budget papers need not  
2 include an original or final budgeted financial statement (a *budgeted*  
3 *statement*) for an affected department.
- 4 (4) If the supplementary budget papers do not include a budgeted  
5 statement for an affected department—
- 6 (a) the supplementary budget papers must state the reasons why  
7 the budgeted statement for the department is not included; and
- 8 (b) the Treasurer must present the budgeted statement for the  
9 department to the Legislative Assembly as soon as practicable  
10 after the passing of the Bill.
- 11 (5) A budgeted statement for a department—
- 12 (a) must include details of the impact on the budget of the  
13 department of all variations to the appropriation which  
14 happened in the financial year before the passing of the Bill;  
15 and
- 16 (b) may show the impact of variations other than those resulting  
17 from additional appropriations.
- 18 **Example (para (b))**  
19 The impact of revised economic forecasts.

20 **5 Treasurer's advance**  
21 **Section 18 (1) (c)**

22 *substitute*

- 23 (c) the need for the expenditure could not reasonably have been  
24 foreseen at the time of presentation to the Legislative  
25 Assembly of the Bill for the first Appropriation Act relating to  
26 the financial year in which the expenditure is to happen; and
