## DETERMINATION OF FEES 1989

UNDER section 9A of the Roads and Public Places Act 1937 I REVOKE the determination of fees published in Commonwealth Gazette No. S 412 of 20 August 1986 and determine that:

- (a) the fee for the opening up or the breaking of the surface of a carriageway which has a surface of the type set out in Column 1 of Schedule 1 shall be the amount set out in or ascertained in accordance with the formula in column 2 of Schedule 1 in relation to that type of surface; and
- (b) the fee for the opening up or the breaking of the surface or a public place, other than a carriageway, which has a surface of the type set out in Column 1 of Schedule 2 shall be the amount set out in or ascertained in accordance with the formula in Column 2 of Schedule 2 in relation to that type of surface.
