


AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY
ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES ACT 1937

DETERMINATION OF FEES 1989

UNDER section 9A of the Roads and Public Places Act 1937 I REVOKE the determination of fees published in Commonwealth Gazette No. S 412 of 20 August 1986 and determine that:

- (a) the fee for the opening up or the breaking of the surface of a carriageway which has a surface of the type set out in Column 1 of Schedule 1 shall be the amount set out in or ascertained in accordance with the formula in column 2 of Schedule 1 in relation to that type of surface; and
- (b) the fee for the opening up or the breaking of the surface of a public place, other than a carriageway, which has a surface of the type set out in Column 1 of Schedule 2 shall be the amount set out in or ascertained in accordance with the formula in Column 2 of Schedule 2 in relation to that type of surface.



Non-paved

A standard concrete pavement (a concrete pavement which (i) is cast in site (ii) has had its surface finished by means of a trowel, float or brush or by the use of hessian; and (iii) has not been coloured)

(a) where the thickness of the pavement does not exceed 75 millimetres

160.00 together with 26.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

(b) where the thickness of the pavement exceeds 75 millimetres

160.00 together with 28.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

(1) A concrete pavement, other than a standard concrete pavement, or (2) a pavement other than:

- (i) a concrete pavement;
- (ii) a bituminous pavement;
- (iii) a bituminous surfaced pavement; or
- (iv) a gravel pavement

(b) where the thickness of the pavement exceeds 75 millimetres

160.00 together with 35.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

Bituminous concrete pavement or bituminous surfaced pavement

160.00 together with 26.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

Block pavement

160.00 together with 77.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

Gravel pavement

160.00 together with 13.00 for each square metre or part of a square metre of surface opened up or broken

Concrete kerbstone or concrete gutter

160.00 together with 32.00 for each lineal metre or part of a lineal metre of surface opened up or broken
