



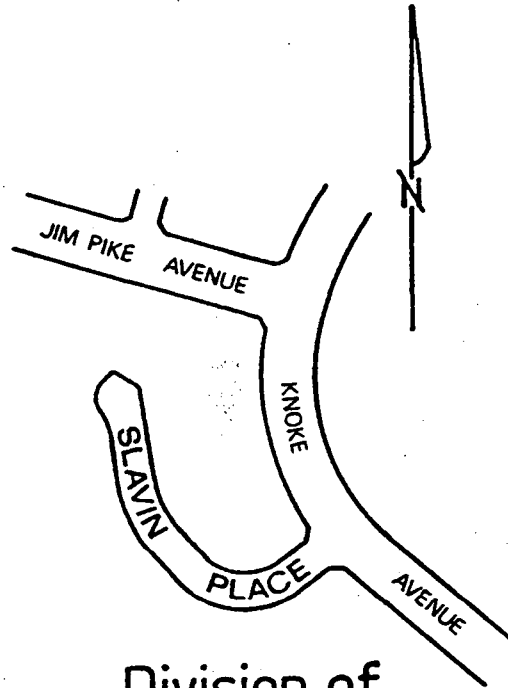
STREET NOMENCLATURE

DIVISION OF GORDON: SPORTSMEN AND WOMEN


NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
SLAVIN PLACE	Frank Slavin (1861-1929)	Boxer. Born Maitland, NSW, he began his boxing career in Queensland in 1885 and became the Australian Heavyweight Champion in 1888. He fought successfully in the US and won the Championship of England in 1889. His career ended in 1907 after 37 contests and 25 wins. He was known as the "Sydney Cornstalk".
