DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 143 of 1992

Under section 50 of the *Pharmacy Act 1931* (the Act), I, Wayne Berry, Deputy Chief Minister for the Australian Capital Territory:

1. REVOKE all previous determinations of fees payable under paragraphs 24 (d) and 26 (1)(b) of the Act, and
2. DETERMINE that the prescribed fees for the purposes of those provisions shall be in accordance with the Schedule.
