

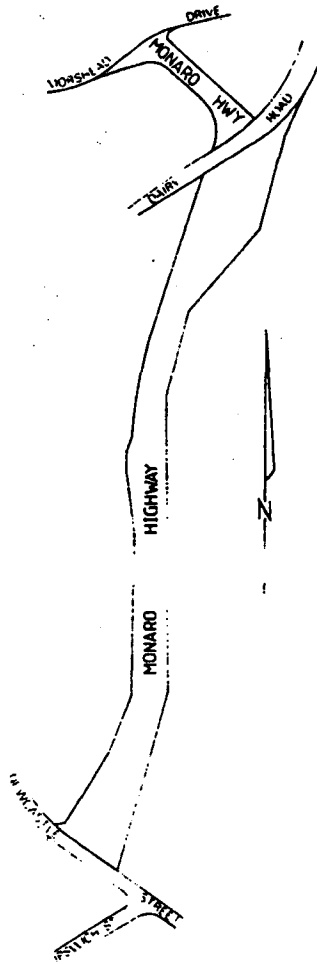
MONARO HIGHWAY
