Statute No. 20

HONORARY DEGREE STATUTE 1992

Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the Honorary Degree Statute 1992.

Repeal

2. The Honorary Degree Statute 1988 (Statute No. 65 of the Canberra College of Advanced Education) is repealed.

Honorary degrees

3. The Council may admit a person to an honorary degree of master or the honorary degree of Doctor of the University, in accordance with rules made under this Statute.

Rules

4. The Council may make rules, not inconsistent with the Act or a Statute, with respect to any matter necessary or convenient for carrying out or giving effect to this Statute and with respect to:

- (a) the requirements for, and the formalities and ceremonies relating to the conferring of, honorary degrees of the University; and
- (b) any other matter incidental to such requirements, formalities and ceremonies.
