LAND (PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENT) ACT 1991

DETERMINATION OF CRITERIA  
FOR DIRECT GRANTS OF CROWN LEASES

NO. (30) OF 1992

The ACT Executive under subsection 161(5) of the Land (Planning and Environment) Act 1991 determines criteria for the direct grant of a Crown lease for RURAL purposes. The criteria are:

The applicant:

- . must complete and sign an application for the lease in the required form giving details of:-
  - name of the proposed lessee;
  - form of tenancy, stating shares if relevant;
  - address for service of notices;
  - proof of company particulars ie directors, shares etc. (if applicable);
- . must be the current occupant of the land, the subject of the application, or the lessee, or occupier of the land adjacent to the land the subject of the application;
- . must demonstrate the capacity to manage the land in accordance with the proposed terms of the lease;
- . must pay the land rent determined by the Territory;
- . must manage the land in accordance with the Land Management Plan agreed to with the appropriate Territory agency; and
- . must pay the fees and charges for the time being notified by the Minister as being applicable.
